AN ORDINANCE providing for the improvement of

Forty-second Avenue Southwest, from Ferry Avenue to West Lander Street, Forty-first Avenue Southwest from three hundred (300) feet north of West Holgate Street to West Lander Street; West Holgate Street from Walnut Avenue to Forty-first Avenue Southwest, Walnut Avenue from Arch Avenue to West Holgate Street; Arch Avenue from West Massachusetts Street to West Holgate Street; West Massachusetts Street from Ferry Avenue to Arch Avenue; Ferry Avenue from Victoria Avenue to California Avenue; Victoria Avenue from Ferry Avenue to One hundred fifty (150) feet south of West Holgate Street; Edgewood Avenue from Ferry Avenue to Palm Avenue; Alley East of Forty-first Avenue Southwest from West Holgate Street to West Hill Street; Georgia Street from the north line of Seattle Tide Lands Plat to intersection of Victoria Avenue and Ferry Avenue, all in the City of Seattle, by constructing sewers therein of proper dimensions and materials, together with all wyes, openings, manholes, flush tanks, catch basins and other appurtenances, and including as a part of this improvement a temporary wooden box outfall sewer in Georgia Street extending from the northerly line of the Seattle Tide Lands Plat to the intersection of Victoria Avenue and Ferry Avenue,

all in accordance with Resolution No. 4366... of the City Council of the City of Seattle, creating a local improvement district therefor, and providing that payment for said improvement be made by special assessments upon property in said district payable by the mode of "Payment by Bonds."

Be It Ordained by the City of Seattle as follows:

Section 1. That

Forty-second Avenue Southwest, from Ferry Avenue to West Lander Street; Forty-first Avenue Southwest from three hundred (300) feet north of West Holgate Street to West Lander Street; West Holgate Street from Walnut Avenue to Forty-first Avenue Southwest; Walnut Avenue from Arch Avenue to West Holgate Street; Arch Avenue from West Massachusetts Street to West Holgate Street; West Massachusetts Street from Ferry Avenue to Arch Avenue; Ferry Avenue from Victoria Avenue to California Avenue; Victoria Avenue from Ferry Avenue to one hundred fifty (150) feet south of West Holgate Street; Edgewood Avenue from Ferry Avenue to Palm Avenue; Alley East of Forty-first Avenue Southwest from West Holgate Street to West Hill Street; Georgia Street from the north line of Seattle Tide Lands Plat to intersection of Victoria Avenue and Ferry Avenue, all in The City of Seattle, be improved by constructing sewers therein of proper dimensions and materials, together with all wyes, openings, manholes, flush tanks, catch basins and other appurtenances, and including as a part of this improvement a temporary wooden box outfall sewer in Georgia Street extending from the northerly line of the Seattle Tide Lands Plat to the intersection of Victoria Avenue and Ferry Avenue,

and that such other work be done as may be necessary in connection therewith, according to the plans and specifications therefor prepared under the direction of the City Engineer and on file in the office the Board of Public Works.

Section 2. That the cost and expense of said improvement, including all necessary and incidental expenses, shall be borne by and assessed against the property included in the assessment district hereinafter created in accordance with law. The City of Seattle shall not be liable in any manner for any portion of the cost and expense of said improvement, except as herein provided.

Section 3. That there is hereby established a local improvement district, to be called "Local Improvement District No. 2779," which said district is described as follows:

"All the property between the termini of said improvement, abutting upon, adjacent, vicinal or proximate to such portion of said streets and avenues to a distance back from the marginal lines thereof, as provided by law."

Section 4. Bonds bearing interest at the rate of 6 per cent per annum payable on or before 10 years from the date of issuance shall be issued in payment of the cost and expense of this improvement, which bonds shall be redeemed by the collection of special assessments to be levied and assessed upon the property within said district, payable in 10 equal annual installments with interest at the rate of 6 per cent per annum, under the mode of "Payment by Bonds" as defined by law and the charter and ordinances of the City of Seattle. These bonds shall be delivered to the contractor in redemption of warrants on the Local Improvement District Fund issued on estimates of the City Engineer, or the City of Seattle, may at its election sell said bonds and make such redemption in cash.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
