

Ordinance No. 334

To provide for the levying and collecting of a special tax for the purpose of raising funds to pay for the construction of a sidewalk on Seventh Street, under Ordinance No. 303

The City of Seattle does ordain as follows:

Section 1.

That a special tax is hereby ordered and levied upon all the property assessed in the special assessment district created by Ordinance No. 303 of thirty-four mills on each and every dollar of the assessed value of said property, to provide funds for the purposes specified in said Ordinance No. 303.

Section 2.

That the City Clerk is hereby directed to make out forth with a list of all taxes hereby levied, certified by him under his hand and the seal of the City and deliver such list so certified to the City Treasurer for collection which said taxes shall be due and payable on or before the 15th day of December 1882

Section 3.

That upon receiving such tax list the City Treasurer shall give notice thereof by advertisement published for five days in the Official newspaper of the City which notice shall designate the time when said taxes are to be paid; and all such taxes not paid on or prior to the 15th December 1882 shall be deemed delinquent, and the City Attorney is hereby directed to proceed to collect such delinquent taxes by action.

Section 4.

That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force at and after the expiration of five days after the same shall have been published
