ORDINANCE NO. 33988

AN ORDINANCE providing for the relief of the unemployed dependent men and women of the City of Seattle, appropriating money from the general fund and prescribing manner of the disbursement thereof, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The sum of \$2,410.00 is hereby appropriated from the general fund for expenditure in the relief and care of the unemployed dependent men and women of the city by renting and repairing the necessary buildings for sleeping and eating quarters, in the purchase of necessary equipment and supplies for said quarters, and in the payment of such wages or salaries as may be necessary to be paid out in the carrying on of such relief work.

Section 2. All expenditures under this ordinance shall be made under the general supervision and control of the Mayor and all moneys paid out under authority hereof shall be paid only after proper vouchers have been presented and approved by the auditing committee of the city.

(Emergency deficit)

Section 3. Whereas, there are not sufficient funds in the treasury of the City of Seattle from miscellaneous receipts or tax levy for the year 19\_\_\_\_; available for the purpose herein specified, nor has said amount been included in the tax levy for the year 19\_\_\_\_; therefor the proper officers of the City of Seattle are authorized and directed to apply unanticipated revenues for the year 19\_\_\_\_ to cover the deficiency in the general fund hereby created, and in the event of such deficiency, or any part thereof, existing at the time of the making of the next general tax levy, an item shall be included therein to pay such deficiency.

Section 4. Whereas, the safety and welfare of the public demand that immediate steps be taken to provide food and shelter for the unemployed dependents as herein provided; therefore, this ordinance shall take effect without delay.

Section 5. By reason of the facts set forth in this ordinance an emergency is declared to exist; therefor this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
