ORDINANCE NO. 34219.

AN ORDINANCE submitting to the qualified voters of the City of Seattle at the general election to be held in said City Tuesday, March 2, 1915, the proposition of the issuance and sale by said City of its general bonds in the sum of Eight Hundred Twenty-nine Thousand, Five Hundred (\$829,500.) Dollars, for the purpose of providing money for the construction of a bridge for the City of Seattle across the Lake Washington Canal and of a bridge across Salmon Bay Waterway.

WHEREAS, the public necessity and convenience require the construction of a bridge across the Government Canal and a bridge across Salmon Bay Waterway, at the locations herein specified, and it is necessary that funds be provided in payment therefor, and

WHEREAS, out of the proceeds of an issue of Three Million (\$3,000,000.) Dollars road and bridge bonds, duly authorized by the voters of King County, the County Commissioners of such county, have set aside the sum of Seventy Thousand (\$70,000.) Dollars in aid of the cost of construction of the proposed bridge at Fremont Avenue (across Lake Washington Canal), now, therefore;

Be it ordained by the City of Seattle as follows:

Section 1. That there be, and hereby is, submitted to the qualified voters of the City of Seattle at the general election to be held in said City on Tuesday, the 2d day of March, 1915, the proposition and question of the issuance and sale by said city of negotiable bonds to the amount of Eight Hundred Twenty-nine Thousand and Five Hundred (\$829,500.) Dollars, which bonds shall bear interest from their date and shall mature in equal annual series, as near as may be, commencing eleven (11) years and ending twenty (20) years after their date, and shall bear a rate of interest of five per cent. (5%) per annum, payable semi-annually, for which interest coupons shall be attached to and be a part of said bonds, and the said bonds and coupons shall be payable at a place therein expressed, for the purpose of providing money for the construction of two (2) bridges for said City to cross the Lake Washington Canal at Fremont Avenue, and Salmon Bay Waterway at Fifteenth Avenue Northwest.

The proceeds of duly authorized King County road and bridge bonds in the sum of Seventy Thousand (\$70,000.) Dollars shall be used in aid of the construction of the bridge at Fremont Avenue (across Lake Washington Canal), which sum is hereby accepted for such purpose. The estimated cost of each bridge in addition to said Seventy Thousand (\$70,000.) Dollars is as follows:

Fifteenth Avenue Northwest (Across Salmon Bay Waterway) - - - - -	\$479,500.
Fremont Avenue (Across Lake Washington Canal)	\$350,000.

The total indebtedness incurred hereunder with the assent of the voters shall be a part of the three and one-half (3½) per cent. of indebtedness authorized by the State Constitution to be incurred upon such assent.

Sec. 2. At the general election to be held in the City of Seattle and the several voting precincts therein on Tuesday, the 2d day of March, 1915, there shall be voted upon by the qualified voters of said city the propositions and questions mentioned in Section 1 of this ordinance; provided that any other proposition or propositions may be submitted for the incurring of any indebtedness by the said city at the same election, in pursuance of any other ordinance or ordinances of said city that may so provide; said election shall be held and conducted in accordance with the provisions of the charter of said city and the general laws of this state.

Sec. 3. The proposition so submitted shall be voted upon as two (2) separate propositions, and in the following manner, to-wit:

PROPOSITION NO. 1.

Every voter at such election electing to vote in favor of said proposed issuance and sale of bonds for the proposed bridge at Fifteenth Avenue Northwest (across Salmon Bay Waterway), shall vote a ballot containing the following statement of said proposition, to-wit:

"IN FAVOR of the proposition and question of the issuance and sale by the City of Seattle of the negotiable bonds of said city to the amount of Four Hundred Seventy-nine Thousand Five Hundred (\$479,500.) Dollars, for the purpose of providing money for the construction of a bridge for the City of Seattle to cross Salmon Bay Waterway at Fifteenth Avenue Northwest, as set forth in detail in Ordinance No. 34219 of said city."

Every voter at such election electing to vote against said proposition shall vote a ballot containing the following statement of said proposition, to-wit:

"AGAINST the proposition and question of the issuance and sale by the City of Seattle of the negotiable bonds of said City to the amount of Four Hundred Seventy-nine Thousand Five Hundred (\$479,500.) Dollars, for the purpose of providing money for the construction of a bridge for the City of Seattle to cross Salmon Bay Waterway at Fifteenth Avenue Northwest, as set forth in detail in Ordinance No. 34219 of said city."

PROPOSITION NO. 2.

Every voter at such election electing to vote in favor of said proposed issuance and sale of bonds for the proposed bridge at Fremont Avenue (across Lake Washington Canal), shall vote a ballot containing the following statement of said proposition, to-wit:

"IN FAVOR of the proposition and question of the issuance and sale by the City of Seattle of its negotiable bonds to the amount of Three Hundred Fifty Thousand (\$350,000.) Dollars, to provide money for the construction of a bridge for the City of Seattle to cross Lake Washington Canal at Fremont Avenue, in addition to Seventy Thousand (\$70,000.) Dollars contributed by King County from its road and bridge bond issue, as set forth in detail in Ordinance No. 34219

of said city."

Every voter at such election electing to vote against said proposition shall vote a ballot containing the following statement of said proposition, to-wit:

"AGAINST the proposition and question of the issuance and sale by the City of Seattle of its negotiable bonds to the amount of Three Hundred Fifty Thousand (\$350,000.) Dollars, to provide money for the construction of a bridge for the City of Seattle to cross Lake Washington Canal at Fremont Avenue, in addition to Seventy Thousand (\$70,000) Dollars contributed by King County from its road and bridge bond issue, as set forth in detail in Ordinance No. 34219 of said city."

**said proposition** Sec. 4. If three-fifths of the qualified voters voting on  
1 at said election shall vote in favor of the issuance and sale of the bonds herein mentioned for one or both of such separate propositions, then the Mayor and City Comptroller are hereby authorized to have printed, engraved or lithographed negotiable bonds of the City of Seattle in the total sum of the specified amounts of bonds as authorized and to execute the same in the name of and under the corporate seal of said city.

Sec. 5. The money derived from the sale of said bonds shall be applied in such separate amounts and for such separate propositions only as shall be authorized by such vote at such **general** election for the construction of a bridge for said city at Fifteenth Avenue Northwest (across Salmon Bay Waterway), and a bridge at Fremont Avenue (across Lake Washington Canal).

Sec. 6. There shall be levied each year by the City Council of said city, in its annual tax levy, a tax upon all the property in said city subject to taxation, sufficient to pay the interest upon said bonds as the same may accrue, and the amount of

such tax, as collected, shall be by the City Treasurer credited to a special fund for the payment of the interest upon said bonds, and no part of such fund shall be diverted to any other purpose than the payment of such interest, and the faith and credit of such city are hereby pledged for the amount, levy and collection of such tax and the regular payment of such interest.

Sec. 7. There shall be levied by the City Council of the City of Seattle in its annual tax levy, in each year during the life of said bonds, commencing with the year preceding the maturity of the earliest maturing bonds, a tax upon all the property in said city subject to taxation sufficient to pay the principal of all of said bonds as the same mature and become payable, and the amount of such tax, as collected, shall be by the proper officers of said city credited to a special fund for the payment of the principal of such bonds, and no part of such fund shall be diverted to any other purpose than the payment of such principal; and the faith, property and credit of said city are hereby pledged for the annual levy and collection of such tax and the payment of the principal of such bonds at the maturity thereof. Such tax shall become due and collectible as other taxes in said city.

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
