ORDINANCE NO. 36874

AN ORDINANCE accepting a deed from Alexander H. Corbett, Bachelor, and William Leitz, Bachelor; and Karolene Runkle, nee Hanson, mortgagee, to the City of Seattle, executed on the 17th day of February, A.D., 1908, and laying off Thirteenth Avenue North.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the deed from Alexander H. Corbett, Bachelor, and William Leitz, Bachelor, and Karolene Runkle, nee Hanson, mortgagee, to the City of Seattle, executed on the 17th day of February, A.D. 1908, to the following described property, to-wit:

Beginning at the southeast corner of Lot Eight (8), Block One (1), as platted in the Portage Addition to The City of Seattle; thence North $0^{\circ}08'32''$ east, City Meridian, along the easterly line of Lots Eight (8), Seven (7) and Six (6), of said Block One (1), a distance of One Hundred Fifty (150) feet, more or less, to the northeast corner of said Lot Six (6); thence South $89^{\circ}30'40''$ W., along the northerly line of said Lot Six (6), a distance of five (5) feet; thence south $0^{\circ}08'32''$ W., on a line five (5) feet distant from and parallel with the said easterly line of said Lots Six (6), Seven (7) and Eight (8), a distance of one hundred fifty (150) feet, more or less, to the southerly line of said Lot Eight (8), Block One (1); thence North $89^{\circ}30'40''$ East, along the southerly line of said Lot Eight (8), a distance of five (5) feet to the point of beginning.

for street purposes, be and the same is hereby accepted.

Section 2. That Thirteenth Avenue North, be and the same is hereby laid off, opened, extended and established over and across the lands described in Section One hereof.

Section ³ This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.

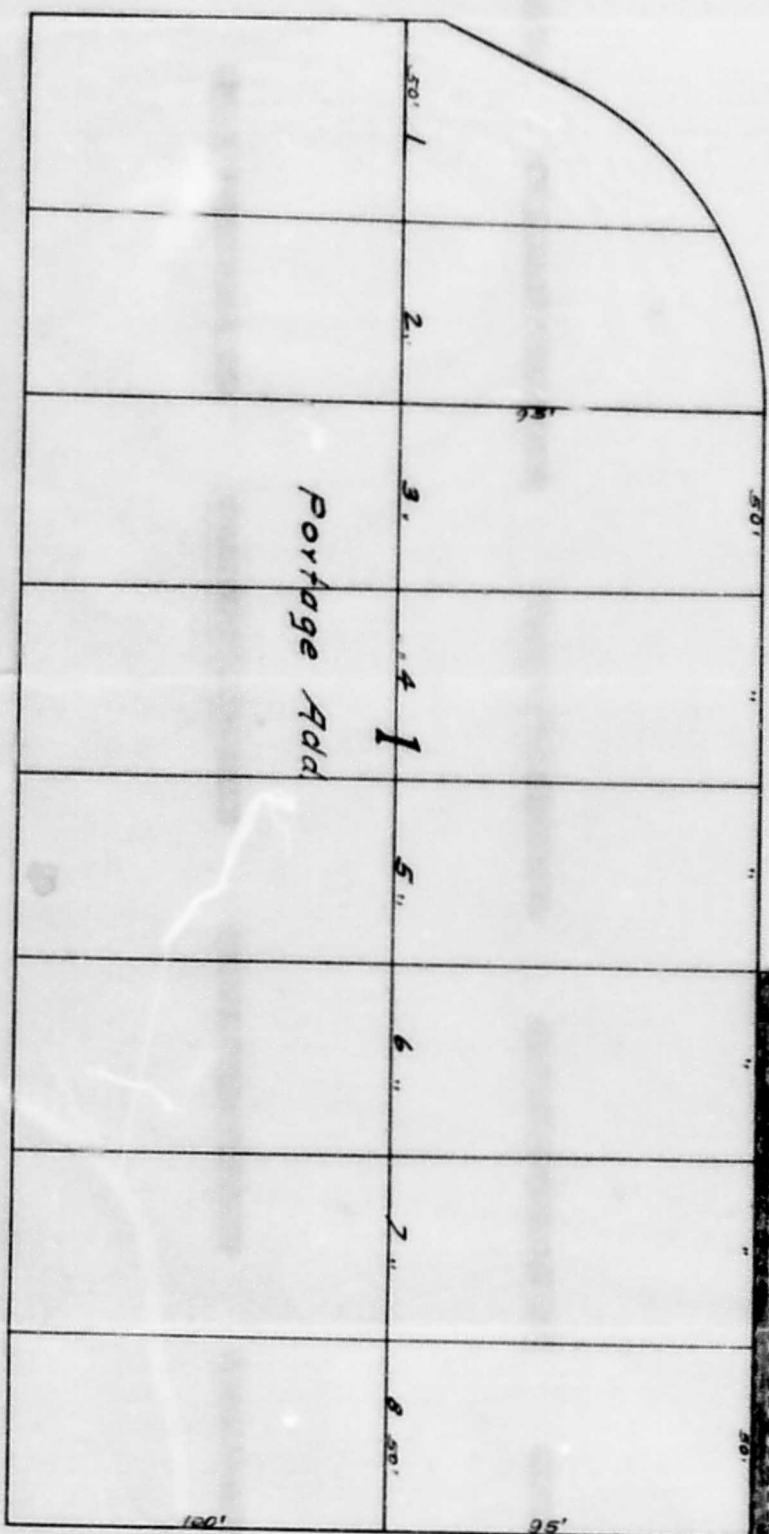
