ORDINANCE NO. 157411

AN ORDINANCE relating to the injury, defacement, destruction, detention, and theft of property belonging in or to, or on deposit with, the Seattle Public Library, or any branch, reading room, deposit station, museum, or institution operated in connection therewith, and providing penalties for the violation thereof.

Be it ordained by the City of Seattle as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to intentionally injure, deface, cut, mark, or destroy any property belonging in or to, or on deposit with, the Seattle Public Library, or any branch, reading room, deposit station, museum, or institution operated in connection therewith.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful to wilfully detain any book, newspaper, magazine, pamphlet, manuscript, or other property belonging in or to, or on deposit with, the Seattle Public Library, or any branch, reading room, deposit station, museum, or institution operated in connection therewith, for thirty (30) days after notice in writing to return the same, given after the expiration of the time which by the rules of such institution such article or other property may be kept; and the said notice shall bear on its face a copy of this section.

Section 3. It shall be unlawful, without the permission of the librarian or an assistant, or by making use of a borrower's card belonging to another without the permission of the owner thereof and the librarian or an assistant, or by color or aid of any fraud or false representation, impersonation or pretense, or by any false token or writing, or by any device or trick, to take from the Seattle Public Library, or any branch, reading room, deposit station, museum, or institution operated in connection therewith, any property belonging therein or thereto.

Section 4. Any person convicted of any violation of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.), or by imprisonment in the city jail for a period of not more than thirty days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
