ORDINANCE NO. 5778

AN ORDINANCE providing for the improvement of
TWENTY-SECOND AVENUE SOUTHWEST, from West Spokane Street to West
Andover Street; TWENTY-THIRD AVENUE SOUTHWEST, from West Spokane Street
to West Genesee Street; TWENTY-FOURTH AVENUE SOUTHWEST, TWENTY-FIFTH
AVENUE SOUTHWEST, and TWENTY-SIXTH AVENUE SOUTHWEST, each from West
Andover Street to West Genesee Street; WEST GENESEE STREET, STANTON
STREET, MARY STREET and WEST DAKOTA STREET, each from Twenty-sixth
Avenue Southwest to Thirtieth Avenue Southwest; YANCY STREET, from
Twenty-sixth Avenue Southwest to Avalon Way; WEST ANDOVER STREET, from
Twenty-fourth Avenue Southwest to Twenty-eighth Avenue Southwest; A
RIGHT OF WAY or EASEMENT to be obtained across Blocks One (1), Four (4),
Five (5), Eight (8), Nine (9), White & Manning's Addition to West Seattle,
now a part of the City of Seattle, from West Andover Street to West
Genesee Street; CHELAN AVENUE, from the West Waterway to West Spokane
Street; WEST SPOKANE STREET, from Chelan Avenue to Twenty-sixth Avenue
Southwest; TWENTY-SIXTH AVENUE SOUTHWEST, from West Spokane Street to
West Andover Street; all in the City of Seattle,

all in accordance with Resolution No. 5522 of the City Council of the City of Seattle, creating a
local improvement district therefor, and providing that payment for said improvement be made by
special assessments upon property in said district payable by the mode of "Payment by Bonds."

Be It Ordained by the City of Seattle as follows:

Section 1. That TWENTY-SECOND AVENUE SOUTHWEST, from West Spokane Street
to West Andover Street; TWENTY-THIRD AVENUE SOUTHWEST, from West Spokane
Street to West Genesee Street; TWENTY-FOURTH AVENUE SOUTHWEST, TWENTY-FIFTH
AVENUE SOUTHWEST, and TWENTY-SIXTH AVENUE SOUTHWEST, each from West Andover
Street to West Genesee Street; WEST GENESEE STREET, STANTON STREET, MARY
STREET and WEST DAKOTA STREET, each from Twenty-sixth Avenue Southwest to
Thirtieth Avenue Southwest; YANCY STREET, from Twenty-sixth Avenue Southwest
to Avalon Way; WEST ANDOVER STREET, from Twenty-fourth Avenue Southwest to
Twenty-eighth Avenue Southwest; A RIGHT OF WAY or EASEMENT to be obtained
across Blocks One (1), Four (4), Five (5), Eight (8) and Nine (9), White &
Manning's Addition to West Seattle, now a part of the City of Seattle, from
West Andover Street to West Genesee Street; all in the City of Seattle; be
improved by constructing sewers therein of the proper dimensions and mater-
ials, together with all necessary wyes, openings, manholes, flush tanks, over-
flow manholes and overflow sewers, catch basins and their appurtenances neces-
sary for the proper sewerage and drainage of said district, and including as
a part of this improvement the construction of a temporary outfall sewer lo-
cated as follows: In CHELAN AVENUE, from the West Waterway to West Spokane
Street; In WEST SPOKANE STREET, from Chelan Avenue to Twenty-sixth Avenue South-
west; In TWENTY-SIXTH AVENUE SOUTHWEST, from West Spokane Street to West Andover
Street;

and that such other work be done as may be necessary in connection therewith, according to the plans
and specifications therefor prepared under the direction of the City Engineer and on file in the office
of the Board of Public Works.

Section 2. That the cost and expense of said improvement, including all necessary and incidental
expenses, shall be borne by and assessed against the property included in the assessment district here-
inafter created in accordance with law. The City of Seattle shall not be liable in any manner for any
portion of the cost and expense of said improvement, except as herein provided.

Section 3. That there is hereby established a local improvement district, to be called "Local Improvement District No. 3102," which said district is described as follows:

"All the property between the termini of said improvement, abutting upon, adjacent, vicinal or proximate to such portion of said streets and avenues to a distance back from the marginal lines thereof, as provided by law."

Section 4. Bonds bearing interest at the rate of 6 per cent per annum payable on or before 12 years from the date of issuance shall be issued in payment of the cost and expense of this improvement, which bonds shall be redeemed by the collection of special assessments to be levied and assessed upon the property within said district, payable in 10 equal annual installments with interest at the rate of 6 per cent per annum, under the mode of "Payment by Bonds" as defined by law and the charter and ordinances of the City of Seattle. These bonds shall be delivered to the contractor in redemption of warrants on the Local Improvement District Fund issued on estimates of the City Engineer, or the City of Seattle, may at its election sell said bonds and make such redemption in cash.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
