ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE relating to persons found in or frequenting places where intoxicating liquor is unlawfully kept or disposed of; providing penalties for violation thereof and declaring an emergency.

Be it ordained by the City of Seattle as follows:

Repealed 102843 Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to frequent or be found in any place where intoxicating liquors are being unlawfully kept or disposed of.

Section 2. Any person found guilty of a violation of the provision of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction, fined in any sum not exceeding one hundred dollars (\$100.00), or imprisoned in the city jail for a term not exceeding thirty (30) days, or may be both fined and imprisoned.

(Emergency)

Section 3 . Whereas, an emergency exists in which it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety that this ordinance shall become effective without delay. Now, Therefore,

Section 4 . By reason of the facts set forth in this ordinance an emergency is declared to exist; wherefore this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
