AN ORDINANCE relating to, and providing for, the construction and installation of certain additions and betterments to, and extensions of, the municipal light and power plant and system specified and adopted in Ordinance No. 38920, approved November 19, 1918, and making an appropriation therefor.

Be it Ordained by the City of Seattle as follows:

Section 1. That the Board of Public Works be, and it is hereby, authorized and directed to prepare and adopt plans and specifications for the construction and installation of a pipe line of suitable material and dimensions from the Cedar River reservoir and basin to the power house now located at or near the said reservoir at Cedar Falls, and thereafter to proceed with the construction and installation of said pipe line either by day labor or by letting a contract or contracts therefor, or partly by day labor and partly by contract or contracts, as may, in its judgment, be for the best interests of the City of Seattle, said pipe line being a part of the additions and betterments to, and extensions of, the municipal light and power plant and system owned and controlled by the City of Seattle set forth in the plan or system specified and adopted in Ordinance No. 38920, approved November 19, 1918.

Section 2. That, in order to carry out the provisions of Section 1 hereof, there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the Municipal Light Extension Bond, 1919, Construction Fund, the sum of One Hundred and Ninety-five Thousand Dollars (\$195,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary therefor.

(To be used for all Ordinances except temporary.)

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
