

Ordinance No. 398

To provide for the Grading and Improvement of Jackson St.
The City of Seattle does ordain as follows:

Section 1.

That Jackson Street be graded and sidewalks be constructed thereon, on both sides thereof, from the east side of Second Street to the west side of Twelfth Street

Section 2.

That said grading shall be done and said sidewalks constructed under the superintendence of the City Surveyor and shall be completed on or before the first day of October 1883.

Section 3.

That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force at and after its passage

Ordinance No. 399

To provide for the Grading and Improvement of South Third St.
The City of Seattle does ordain as follows:

Section 1.

That South Third Street be graded and sidewalks constructed thereon, on both sides thereof, from the south line of Mill Street to the north side of King Street.

Section 2.

That said improvement shall be made under the superintendence and subject to the approval of the City Surveyor and shall be completed on or before the first day of September 1883

Section 3.

That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force at and after its passage.

Ordinance No 400.

To provide for the Grading of, and the Construction of a Side-walk on, a portion of Pike Street.

The City of Seattle does ordain as follows:

Section 1.

That Pike Street be graded from the east side of Front Street to the middle of the alley between Front and Second Streets.

Section 2.

That sidewalks be constructed on both sides of Pike Street from the east side of Front Street to the East side of Third Street.

Section 3.

That said grading be done and said sidewalks constructed under the superintendence of the City Surveyor, and subject to his approval, and that the same shall be completed on or before the first day of August 1883.

Section 4.

That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force at and after its passage
