## ORDINANCE NO. 433273

AN ORDINANCE providing for the laying off, opening, extending and establishing of a public alley twenty (20) feet in width over and across a portion of Section Nineteen (19), Township Twenty-four (24) North, Range Four (4) East, W.M., from East Marginal Way to Commercial Waterway No. 1; providing for the condemnation, appropriation, taking and damaging of land and other property necessary for the layingoff, opening, extending and establishing of the above described alley; and providing that the entire cost of said improvement shall be paid by special assessments upon the property specially benefited in the manner provided by law;

WHEREAS, public necessity and convenience demand that the above named alley be laid off, opened, extended and established as a public alley, street, and highway; and

WHEREAS, such improvement will be of special benefit to certain lands, premises and other property, NOW, THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a public alley twenty (20) feet in width over and across a portion of Section Nineteen (19), Township Twenty-four (24) North, Range Four (4) East, W.M., from East Marginal Way to Commercial Waterway No. 1, be and the same is hereby laid off, opened, extended and established over and across the following lots, blocks, or tracts of land, to-wit:

That portion of Government Lot Two (2), Government Lot Twelve (12), and the filled bed of Duwsmish River, lying between said Government Lots, all in Section 19, Township 24 North, Range 4 East, W.M., described as follows: Beginning at a point on the west margin of East Marginel Way, said point being north nineteen degrees, thirty-six minutes, twenty-three seconds (19°36'23") west one hundred ninety-five and four one-hundredths (195.04) feet from the intersection of said west margin with the east and west center line of said section; thence north 79° 35' 39" west a distance of eight hundred eighty-four and nineteen one-hundredths (884.19) feet to a

point on the meander line forming the southwesterly boundary line of said Government Lot twelve (12); thence north 24° 36' 48" west along said meander line a distance of twenty-four and forty-two one-hundredths (24.42) feet; thence south 79° 35' 39" east a distance of eight hundred twenty-eight and forty-one-hundredths (828.40) feet; thence north 32° 26' 50" east a distance of sixty-three and ninety-six one-hundredths (63.96) feet to a point on the west margin of East Marginal Way; thence south 19° 36' 23" east along said west margin a distance of ninety-one and fifty-six one-hundredths (91.56) feet to the point of beginning.

Section 2. That all lands, rights, privileges and other property lying within the limits of the lots, blocks, or tracts of land described in Section 1 hereof, be and the same are hereby condemned, appropriated, taken and damaged for the purpose of a public elley, street and highway forever.

Section 3. That the entire cost of the improvement provided for herein shall be paid by special assessments upon property specially benefited in the manner provided by law and that no part thereof shall be paid from the General Fund of The City of Seattle.

Section 4. That the Corporation Counsel be, and he is hereby, authorized and directed to begin and prosecute the actions and proceedings in the manner provided by law to condemn, take, damage and appropriate the lands and other property necessary to carry out the provisions of this ordinance and also to take the steps necessary to make such special assessment.

Section 5.. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
