ORDINANCE NO. 46343

AN ORDINANCE providing for the laying off, opening, widening, extending and establishing of a public street and alley over and across portions of Tracts 8, 9 and 10, Claremont Home Tracts, now a portion of The City of Seattle, from Dakota Street to Andover Street; providing for the condemnation, appropriation, taking and damaging of lands and other property necessary therefor; providing that the entire cost of said improvement be paid by special assessment upon property specially benefited in the manner provided by law.

WHEREAS, public necessity and convenience demand that a public street and alley from Dakota Street to Andover Street be laid off, opened, widened, extended and established, and,

WHEREAS, such improvement will be of special benefit to certain lands, premises and other property, NOW,
THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a public street and alley, from Dakota Street to Andover Street, be and the same is hereby laid off, opened, widened, extended and established over and across the following lots, blocks or tracts of land, to-wit:

The east 16 feet of Tracts, 8, 9 and 10, Claremont Home Tracts, now a portion of The City of Seattle, as shown in Volume 11, of Plats, Page 40, Records of King County, Washington.

Section 2. That all lands, rights, privileges and other property lying within the limits of the lots, blocks and tracts of land described in Section One (1) hereof, be and the same are hereby condemned, appropriated, taken and damaged as a public street and alley, and highway, forever.

Section 3. That the entire cost of the improvement provided for herein shall be paid by special assessment upon the property specially benefited, in the manner provided by law, and that no part thereof shall be paid from the General Fund of the City of Seattle.

Section 4. That the Corporation Counsel be, and he is hereby authorized and directed to begin and prosecute the actions and proceedings, in the manner provided by law, to condemn, take, damage and appropriate the lands and other property necessary to carry out the provisions of this ordinance and also to take the steps necessary to make such special assessment.

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
