47115 ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE, providing fo the laying off, extending and establishing of a public easement for street purposes from East Prospect Street to East Park Place; providing for the condemnation, appropriation, and damaging of property necessary therefor; providing for the establishing of the grade of said easement from East Prospect Street to East Park Place; and providing that the entire cost of said improvement shall be paid by special assessment upon the property specially benefited in the manner provided by law, or from such fund as the City Council may direct.

WHEREAS, Public necessity and convenience demand that Poylston Avenue North from East Prospect Street to East Park Place be laid off, extended and established as a public street an highway and that the grade of said easement from East Prospect Street to gast Park Place be established, and

WHEREAS, Seid improvement will be of special benefit to certain lands, premises and other property; NOW, THEREFORE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Boylston Avenue North, from East Prospect Street to East Park Place be and the same is hereby laid off, extended and established as a public street and highway over the following lot, block or tract of land, to-wit:

> A strip of land twenty (20) feet in width within the limits of Boylston Avenue Eorth heretofore the limits of Boylston Avenue North heretofore vacated by Ordinance No. 24825, said strip conforming to the improved portion of said Boylston Avenue North as the same has been improved and is now used for driveway purposes, an accurate and technical description of said easement to be determined by the City Engineer through the survive thereof survey thereof.

Section 2. That the grade of the easement provided for in Section 1 hereof be and the seas is hereby fixed at existing grade of said portion of Boylston Avenue North now used for driveway purposes.

Section 3. That the rights, privileges and other property, lying within the limits of the lot, block or tract of land described in Section 1 hereof, be and the same are hereby condemned, appropriated and damaged to the public use for the purpose of a public street and highway, and that all rights, privileges and other property, to be taken, used or damaged in conformity with the grade established in Section 2 hereof, are hereby condemned, appropriated and damaged to the public use for such purpose; said rights, privileges and other property are to be taken, appropriated and damaged only after just compensation has been made or paid into court for the owner in the manner provided by law.

Section 4. That the entire cost of the improvement provided for herein shall be paid by special assessment upon the property specially benefited in the manner provided by law, or from such fund as the City Council may direct.

Section. 5. That the Corporation Counsel be and he is hereby authorized and directed to begin and prosecute the actions and proceedings in the manner provided by law, to condemn, take, damage and appropriate the property and property rights necessary to carry out the provisions of this ordinance, and also to take the steps necessary to make such special assessment.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
