ORDINANCE NO. 50596

AN ORDINANCE accepting a deed from W. W. Shields, as Treasurer of King County, State of Washington, to the City of Seattle, and laying off 48th Avenue South.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the deed from W. W. Shields, as Treasurer of King County, State of Washington, to the City of Seattle, executed on the 13th day of March, 1926, to the following described property, to-wit:

A strip of land 50 feet in width over and across a portion of the northeast  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the northeast  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 34, Township 24 North, Range 4 East, W.M., King County, State of Washington, being 25 feet when measured at right angles on each side of the center line extended north of 48th Avenue South, as platted in Moore's Addition to Rainier Boulevard Addition and extending from the north line of said addition to the north line of said subdivision, less the northerly 30 feet thereof.

for street purposes, be and the same is hereby accepted.

Section 2. That 48th Avenue South be and the same is hereby laid off, opened, extended and established over and across the lands described in Section One (1) hereof.

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section 2... This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
