ORDINANCE NO. 50940

AN ORDINANCE Providing for the laying off, opening, extending and establishing of a public street and highway to be known as WEBSTER STREET, from Duwamish Avenue to a point approximately one hundred fifty (150) feet southwesterly therefrom; providing for the condemnation, appropriation, taking and damaging of land and other property necessary therefor; and providing that the entire cost of said improvement shall be paid by special assessment upon the property specially benefited, in the manner provided by law.

WHEREAS, public necessity and convenience demand that the above named street be laid off, opened, extended and established; and,

WHEREAS, such improvement will be of special benefit to certain lands, premises and other property, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a public street and highway to be known as WEBSTER STREET, from Duwamish Avenue to a point approximately one hundred fifty (150) feet southwesterly therefrom, be and the same is hereby laid off, opened, extended and established over and across the following lot, block or tract of land, to-wit:

That portion of S. A. Maple's Donation Claim lying in Section Twenty-eight (28), Township Twenty-four (24) North, Range Four (4) East, W. M., described as follows:

Beginning at the southeast corner of said Maple's Donation Claim; thence north 0° 34' 50" east along the east line of said Donation Claim a distance of seventy and fifty-two one-hundredths (70.52) feet to an intersection with the southwesterly margin of Duwamish Avenue, as now established; thence north 38° 25' 10" west along said southwesterly margin a distance of eighty-nine and seventy-eight one-hundredths (89.78) feet to the true point of beginning; thence south 51° 41' 21" west a distance of one hundred nine and fifty-nine one-hundredths (109.59) feet; thence south 38° 18' 39" east a distance of five (5) feet; thence

south $51^{\circ} 41' 21''$ west a distance of forty (40) feet; thence north $38^{\circ} 18' 39''$ west a distance of forty (40) feet; thence north $51^{\circ} 41' 21''$ east a distance of forty (40) feet; thence south $38^{\circ} 18' 39''$ east a distance of five (5) feet; thence north $51^{\circ} 41' 21''$ east a distance of one hundred nine and fifty-three one-hundredths (109.53) feet to an intersection with the southwesterly margin of Duwamish Avenue, as now established; thence southeasterly along said southwesterly margin a distance of thirty (30) feet to the true point of beginning.

Section 2. That all lands, rights, privileges and other property lying within the limits of the lot, block, and tract of land described in Section one (1) hereof, be and the same are hereby condemned, appropriated, taken and damaged as a public street and highway.

Section 3. That the entire cost of the improvement provided for herein shall be paid by special assessment upon the property specially benefited, in the manner provided by law, and that no part thereof shall be paid from the General Fund of the City of Seattle.

Section 4. That the Corporation Counsel be, and he is hereby authorized and directed to begin and prosecute the actions and proceedings, in the manner provided by law to condemn, take, damage and appropriate the lands and other property necessary to carry out the provisions of this ordinance and also to take the steps necessary to make such special assessment.

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section 5 This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
