ORDINANCE NO. 56064

AN ORDINANCE providing for the acquisition, by condemnation or purchase, of land and other property for park and boulevard purposes on 34th Avenue South between Charles Street and Norman Street and providing that the entire cost of the same shall be paid from the Seattle General Municipal Improvement Bonds 1927 Construction Fund;

WHEREAS, public necessity and convenience demand that certain property on 34th Avenue South between Charles Street and Norman Street shall be acquired for park and boulevard purposes; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That certain property on 34th Avenue South between Charles Street and Norman Street, to-wit:

The east 35 feet of Lots 7 to 12 inclusive, block 45, Burke's 2nd Addition to the City of Seattle, according to Volume 1 of Plats, Page 248;

shall be acquired by condemnation or purchase.

Section 2. That all lands, rights, privileges and other property lying within the lots, blocks or tracts of land described in Section 1 hereof, be and the same are hereby condemned, appropriated, taken and damaged for park and boulevard purposes, or the same shall be acquired by purchase.

Section 3. That the entire cost of the improvement provided for herein shall be paid from the Seattle General Municipal Improvement Bonds 1927 Construction Fund.

Section 4. That the Corporation Counsel be and he is hereby authorized and directed to begin and prosecute the actions and proceedings, in the manner provided by law, to condemn, take, damage and appropriate the lands and other property necessary to carry out the provisions of this ordinance, or to acquire the same by purchase.

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
