ORDINANCE NO. 56097

AN ORDINANCE Vacating the Alley in Block 18, Denny's Addition to Ballard, and Seattle, on the petition of the Pacific Telephone & Telegraph Company, et al.

WHEREAS There has been filed with the City Council the petition of the Pacific Telephone & Telegraph Company, et al., (File No. 116174) asking for the vacation of the Alley in Block 18, Denny's Addition to Ballard and Seattle; and

WHEREAS At the hearing on said petition on the 4th day of September, 1928, the said petition was duly granted by the City Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Alley in Block 18, Denny's Addition to Ballard and Seattle, as laid out on the plat of said addition, and recorded in Volume 14 of Plats, Page 16, Records of King County, Washington, be and the same is hereby vacated.

Section This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
