AN ORDINANCE appropriating the sum of Eighty (\$80.00) Dollars from the General Fund for the payment of the costs of transportation for certain indigent natives of the Philippine Islands.

Be it ordained by the City of Seattle as follows:

Section 1. That the sum of Eighty (\$80.00) Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated from the general Fund for the payment of the costs of transportation for certain indigent persons natives of the Philippine Islands and now in charge of the Charity Organization Society of Seattle.

Section 2. That the Mayor and City Comptroller be and they are hereb by authorized and directed to draw a warrant upon the General Fund in favor of the Charity Organization Society of Seattle for the sum of Fighty (\$80.00) Dollars for the purposes named in Section 1 of this ordinance.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the City of the court of the city.
