AN ORDINANCE providing for the vacation of a portion of Wallingford Avenue, on the petition of Seattle Lighting Company.

Whereas, there has been filed with the City Council the petition of Seattle Lighting Company (File No. 117787) asking for the vacation of that portion of Wallingford Avenue lying south of Northlake Avenue and north of the Northern Pacific Railway Company's right-of-way; and

Whereas, at the hearing on said petition on the 22nd day of April, 1929, the said petition was duly granted by the City Council;

Now Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That that portion of Wallingford Avenue, in the City of Seattle, lying south of Northlake Avenue and north of the Northern Pacific Railway Company's right-of-way; be and the same is hereby vacated.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
