ORDINANCE NO. 57722

AN ORDINANCE relating to and providing for the condemnation of certain lands in the Cedar River Water Shed above an elevation of approximately three thousand feet, according to the United States Geological Survey datum, for the conservation of the water supply of the City.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That public necessity demands that the lands described in Section 2 hereof in the Cedar River Water Shed, being all the privately owned lands lying above an elevation of approximately three thousand feet, according to the United States Geological Survey datum, be condemned, appropriated and taken for public use, to-wit: For the conservation of the water supply of the City.

Section 2. That the following described property, to-wit:

The Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter and the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 10; the South Half of the Southwest Quarter of Section 11; all of Section 15; the South Half of the Northeast Quarter and the East Half of the Southeast Quarter and the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 16; all of Section 22; the West Half of Section 23 and the West Half of Section 25; all of Section 27; the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 34; and all of Section 35, Township 22 North, Range 8 East, W. M.;

The North Half of Section 1; the Northeast Quarter of Section 2 and the West Half of Section 2, and the East Half of the Northeast Quarter and the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 3; Township 21 North, Range 8 East, W. M.;

The Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter; the Southwest Quarter and the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 5; the South Half and the South Half of the Northwest Quarter of Section 9; Lot 1 of Section 11; the North Half, the Southeast Quarter and the East Half of the Southwest Quarter of Section 15; Lot 6 of Section 19; Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 7, 8 and the West Half of the Northeast Quarter of Section 23; the North Half of the Northeast Quarter of Section 25; all of Section 31; the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter and the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 33 and all of Section 35, Township 22 North, Range 9 East, W. M.;

All of Sections 1, 3, 5, 7, 9, 11, 13, 15 and 23 of Township 21 North, Range 9 East, W. M.;

The Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter and the South Half of the Southwest Quarter of Section 27; the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter; the North Half of the Southeast Quarter and the South Half of the Northeast Quarter of Section 29; all of Section 31 and the South Half and the South Half of the North Half of Section 35, Township 22 North, Range 10 East, W. M.;

All of Sections 1, 3, 5, 7, 9, 11, 13, 15,  
17, 19, 21, 23, 25 and 27, Township 21 North, Range  
10 East, W. M.;

All of Sections 5, 7, 17, and 19, Township 21  
North, Range 11 East, W. M.;

All of Section 31, Township 22 North, Range 11  
East, W. M.,

be, and the same is hereby, condemned, appropriated and taken for  
public use, to-wit: For the conservation of the water supply of  
the City.

Section 3. That the cost and expense of this improve-  
ment shall be paid from the proceeds of a sale of bonds to be  
made pursuant to Ordinance No. 27400, or from such other fund as the  
City Council may provide.

Section 4. That the Corporation Counsel be, and he is  
hereby, authorized and directed to begin and prosecute the actions  
and proceedings in the manner provided by law, to condemn, take,  
damage and appropriate the lands, and other property, necessary  
to carry out the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
