ORDINANCE NO. 58276

AN ORDINANCE relating to and providing for the condemnation, appropriation, taking and damaging of land and other property in Tracts 39 and 40, Somerville, An Addition to the City of Seattle, recorded in Volume 2 of Plats, Page 63, for park and playground purposes, and providing that the entire cost thereof shall be paid by special assessment upon the property specially benefited, in the manner provided by law, or from such fund as the City Council of the City of Seattle may provide, or by both special assessment and from such fund.

WHEREAS, public necessity and convenience demand that certain lands, premises and other property be condemned, appropriated and taken for park and playground purposes; and

WHEREAS, such improvement will be of special benefit to certain lands, premises and other property, Now, Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the following described lots, blocks and tracts of land, to-wit:

All of Tract 39, Somerville, an Addition to the City of Seattle, recorded in Volume 2 of Plats Page 63, except portion taken for Beacon Avenue; and all of Tract 40, said Addition;

be and the same are hereby condemned, appropriated, taken and damaged for park and playground purposes.

Section 2. That the entire cost of the improvement provided for herein shall be paid by special assessment upon the property specially benefited, in the manner provided by law, or from such fund as the City Council of the City of Seattle may provide, or by both such fund and special assessment.

Section 3. That the Corporation Counsel be and he is hereby authorized and directed to begin and prosecute the actions and proceedings in the manner provided by law to condemn, take, damage and appropriate the lands and other property necessary to carry out the provisions of this ordinance, and also to take the steps necessary to make such special assessment.

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
