AN ORDINANCE Accepting deeds for easement from E. O. Gifford and Carrie L. Gifford, his wife, to The City of Seattle, and from others to the City of Seattle.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the deed from E. O. Gifford and Carrie L. Gifford, his wife, to The City of Seattle, executed on the 13th day of May, 1930, to the following described property:

for sewer purposes, be and the same are hereby accepted.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
