ORDINANCE NO. 62517

AN ORDINANCE relating to, and providing for, the condemnation, appropriation and taking of the East Half (E.½) of Block Twenty-four (24), State Addition No. 4, for park and playground purposes, and providing that the entire cost thereof shall be paid from the Park Fund.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That public necessity and convenience demand that the property hereinafter described in Section 2 hereof be condemned, appropriated and taken for park and playground purposes.

Section 2. That the following described real estate, situated in Seattle, King County, Washington, to-wit:

The East one-half (E.½) of Block Twenty-four (24), State Addition No. 4,

be, and the same is hereby, condemned, appropriated and taken for park and playground purposes.

Section 3. That the entire cost of the improvement provided for herein shall be paid from the Park Fund.

Section 4. That the Corporation Counsel be, and he is hereby, authorized and directed to begin and prosecute the actions and proceedings in the manner provided by law to condemn and take the lands and other property necessary to carry out the provisions of this ordinance.

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
