ORDINANCE NO. 65815

AN ORDINANCE providing for the condemnation, appropriation, taking and damaging of land and other property in Blocks 11 and 12, York Addition to the City of Seattle, for park and playground purposes; and providing for payment therefor.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That public necessity and convenience demand that the property hereinafter described in Section 2 hereof be condemned, appropriated and taken for park and playground purposes.

Section 2. That the following described real estate situated in Seattle, King County, Washington, to-wit:

Lots 9, 10, 11 and 12, in Block 11, and Lots 4 and 5, in Block 12, all in York Addition to the City of Seattle, recorded in Volume 10 of Plats, at page 84;

be, and the same is hereby, condemned, appropriated and taken for park and playground purposes.

Section 3. That the entire cost of the improvement provided for herein shall be paid by special assessment upon the property specially benefited.

Section 4. That the Corporation Counsel be, and he is hereby, directed to begin and prosecute the actions and proceedings necessary, in the manner provided by law, to condemn, take and appropriate the lands and other property necessary to carry out the provisions of this ordinance; and also to take the steps necessary to make such special assessment.

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
