AN ORDINANCE Naming the alleys in Blocks 41 and 42 Denny-Fuhrman Addition PORTAGE BAY PLACE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the alley in Block 41 and the alley in Block 42 of the Denny-Fuhrman Addition, being the alleys northeasterly of Fuhrman Avenue and extending from Allison Street to Eastlake Avenue, be and the same are, hereby, named and designated PORTAGE BAY PLACE.

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
