ORDINANCE NO. 66340

AN ORDINANCE relating to and providing for the preparation of plans for the Cowen Park Bridge and for the Paving of 4th Avenue South, appropriating additional funds therefor, and amending Section 2 of Ordinance No. 65798, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 65798, entitled:

"An Ordinance authorizing and directing the City Engineer to proceed with the preparation of plans for the Cowen Park Bridge and for the Paving of 4th Avenue South, and appropriating money therefor",

as amended by Ordinance No. 65955 and Ordinance No. 66187, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. That the sum of Five Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$5,200.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated from the Gas Tax Highway Fund for the purpose set forth in Section 1 hereof.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
