ORDINANCE NO. 66846

AN ORDINANCE repealing Ordinances Nos. 57584, 53274, 53782 and 54567, relating to public dancing in public dance halls, cabarets, cafes, hotels and restaurants.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 57584, entitled:

"AN ORDINANCE relating to and regulating dance halls, prohibiting discrimination against men in uniform and amending Section 79 of Ordinance No. 48022 (License Code).",

approved May 22, 1929; Ordinance No. 63274, entitled:

"AN ORDINANCE relating to public dances and dance halls; providing closing hours therefor; prohibiting the operation thereof on Sundays near places of public worship or upon the filing of a protest, and amending Section 61 of Ordinance No. 48022 (The License Code)."

approved December 27, 1932; Ordinance No. 63782, entitled:

"AN ORDINANCE relating to and regulating public dancing and public dance halls; prohibiting female employees from dancing or partaking of refreshments with patrons thereof and amending the License Code (Ordinance No. 48022) by adding thereto an additional section, numbered 83-B.",

approved June 20, 1933; and Ordinance No. 54567, entitled:

"AN ORDINANCE relating to, and providing for, the licensing and regulating of certain occupations, businesses, vocations, trades, callings, amusements, places of amusement, exhibitions, entertainments, animals, motor vehicles, boats, places and establishments; and amending Sections 58 and 83, as amended, of Ordinance No. 48022.",

approved April 3, 1934, be, and the same are hereby, repealed.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
