ORDINANCE NO. 68414

AN ORDINANCE accepting the offer of the United States of America to the City of Seattle to aid, by way of a grant, in financing the construction of East 45th Street Viaduct and Montlake Boulevard Pedestrian Overcrossing, Docket No. Wash. 1271-F, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the offer of the United States of America to the City of Seattle to aid, by way of a grant, in financing the construction of East 45th Street Viaduct and Montlake Boulevard Pedestrian Overcrossing, Docket No. Wash. 1271-F, a copy of which offer reads as follows:

"Washington, D.C.,
June 28, 1938
Docket No. Wash. 1271-F.

The City of Seattle,
Seattle, Washington.

1. Subject to the Terms and Conditions (PWA Form No. 230, as amended to the date of this Offer) which are made a part hereof, the United States of America hereby offers to aid in financing the construction of viaducts, approaches and street improvements (herein called the "Project"), by making a grant to The City of Seattle (herein called the "Applicant"), in the amount of 45 per cent of the cost of the Project upon completion, as determined by the Federal Emergency Administrator of Public Works, but not to exceed, in any event, the sum of \$103,500.

2. By acceptance of this Offer the Applicant covenants to begin work on the Project as early as possible but in no event later than 9 weeks from the date of this Offer and to complete such Project with all practicable dispatch, and in any event within 14 months from the commencement of construction.

the original of which offer, properly executed by the Federal Emergency Administrator of Public Works, together with the annexed copy of the Terms and Conditions (PWA Form No. 230, as amended to the date of this Offer) has been filed in the office of the City Comptroller and Ex-Officio City Clerk and become City Comptroller's

File No. 159561, and is by reference made a part of this ordinance, be and the same is hereby in all respects accepted.

Section 2. That said City of Seattle agrees to abide by all the terms and conditions relating to such grant, a copy of which terms and conditions were annexed to the Government's offer and made a part thereof.

Section 3. That the City Comptroller be and he is hereby authorized and directed forthwith to send to the Federal Emergency Administration of Public Works three certified copies of this ordinance and three certified copies of the proceedings of this Council in connection with the passage of this ordinance, and such further documents or proofs in connection with the acceptance of said offer as may be requested by the Federal Emergency Administration of Public Works.

(Emergency)

Section 4. Whereas, the grant referred to herein is essential in order to finance certain public improvements necessary for the preservation of the public safety, and

Whereas, to be effective the offer of grant must be accepted and the work started immediately, NOW, THEREFORE,

Section 5. By reason of the facts set forth in this ordinance an emergency is declared to exist; therefore, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval, if approved by the Mayor; if not so approved it shall take effect and become a law at the time and in the manner provided for non-emergency ordinances under the provisions of the city charter.
