ORDINANCE NO. 69577.

AN ORDINANCE providing for the refund of \$120.00 deposited as rental for the Civic Auditorium on October 13, 14 and 15, making an appropriation therefor and declaring the emergency making necessary such appropriation.

WHEREAS, the rental agreement for use of the Civic Auditorium on October 13, 14 and 15 for the engagement of "A Night at the Moulin Rouge" was cancelled by the City; and,

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Buildings has recommended (Comptroller's File No. 163937) the return of the rental deposit made for such engagement, in the sum of \$120.00; Now, Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the rental deposit, lease No. 939, Treasurer's Receipt No. D 56108, in the sum of One Hundred Twenty Dollars (\$120.00), heretofore made for the use of the Civic Auditorium on October 13, 14 and 15, for the engagement of "A Night at the Moulin Rouge" is hereby refunded to W. R. Forman. That to effectuate such refund the sum of One Hundred Twenty Dollars (\$120.00) is hereby appropriated from the Emergency Fund and the City Comptroller is hereby authorized and directed to draw and deliver, and the City Treasurer to honor and pay, the necessary warrant therefor.

Section 2. WHEREAS, the appropriation herein made is necessary to meet the actual expenditures of the Department of Buildings hereby authorized, for which no appropriation was made in the 1939 Budget, due to causes which could not reasonably have been foreseen at the time of making said Budget; Now, Therefore, in accordance with Section 9000-19, Rem. Rev. Stat., this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon the approval of the same by the Mayor or the passage thereof over his veto as provided by Charter.

PASSED by the City Council by unanimous vote of all its members this 6 day of November, 1939, and signed by me in open session in authentication of its passage this 6 day

of November, 1939.
