ORDINANCE NO. 69769

AN ORDINANCE relating to garbage disposal; providing for the acquisition of property in connection with certain sanitary fill sites; making an appropriation from the Emergency Fund therefor; and declaring the emergency making necessary such appropriation.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 69545, supervision and control of all garbage sanitary fill sites was vested in the Board of Public Works; and,

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended (Comptroller's File No. 163410) that certain property be acquired in connection with the sanitary fills on 21st Avenue South in the vicinity of Charles and Weller Streets, and that certain property at 17th Avenue West and West Barrett Street be exchanged; Now, Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the City Engineer under the direction and supervision of the Board of Public Works be, and he is hereby, authorized for and on behalf of the City, to negotiate for and acquire the property necessary and convenient to the making of certain sanitary fills at 21st Avenue South in the vicinity of Charles and Weller Streets, and also to negotiate for and to make an exchange of property with the owners of Lots Six (6) and Seven (7), Block One Hundred Twenty-three (123), Gilman's Addition.

Section 2. That in order to effectuate the above purpose the sum of Twenty-two Thousand, Five Hundred Dollars (\$22,500.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, be, and the same is hereby, appropriated from the Emergency Fund; and the City Comptroller be, and he is hereby, authorized and directed to draw and deliver, and the City Treasurer to honor and pay, the necessary warrants therefor upon approval in writing by the City Engineer of the several items thereof.

Section 3. WHEREAS, the expenditures hereinabove authorized are necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health

and could not have been anticipated at the time of the preparation of the 1940 Budget, which contains no item therefor; Now, Therefore, by reason of the facts above stated, and the emergency which is hereby declared to exist, this ordinance shall be effective immediately upon the approval or signing of the same by the Mayor or passage of same over his veto as provided by the Charter of the City.

PASSED by three-fourths vote of the City Council the 13 day of February, 1940, and signed by me in open session in authentication of its passage this 13 day of February, 1940.
