ORDINANCE NO. 69816

AN ORDINANCE relating to, and granting, leaves of absence to officers and employees of the City while in active military or naval service, and providing for contributions by members to the Retirement System while on such leaves of absence.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Any officer or employee of the City who, after December 1, 1939, has been or thereafter may be called, sworn or mustered into the active military or naval service of the United States or accepted for training in any regularly constituted camp or school of instruction maintained and conducted by the United States Government in the preparation of officers or men for such service, shall be given leave of absence without pay except as and to the extent provided by Chapter 113, Laws of 1939, while in said service or in said camp or school without loss of position, rating or eligibility by reason of such absence.

Section 2. That any member of the City Employees' Retirement System who shall make his normal contributions to such system while on leave of absence, as provided in Section 1 hereof, or after his return to City service in monthly payments at least equal and in addition to the current normal contribution then due such system from said member, shall during such absence be entitled to all rights, privileges and benefits, including service credit, allowance under such system: Provided, that any retirement or other allowance to which a member may become entitled pursuant to this ordinance shall be suspended during the time that and insofar as it does not exceed other pension or other compensation received by the beneficiary for service to the United States, any state, municipal corporation or other public service paid from direct or indirect United States, state, municipal or publicly-owned utility, taxes or revenues.
