ORDINANCE NO. 71983

AN ORDINANCE relating to expenditures for civilian protection; authorizing a \$10,000.00 expenditure for a recreation center for colored troops; and amending Section 1 of Ordinance No. 71706 accordingly.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 71706, approved February 24, 1942, entitled:

"AN ORDINANCE authorizing expenditures for civilian protection against the enemy; making an appropriation from the Emergency Fund for such purpose; declaring the emergency therefor; transferring the necessary funds from the General Fund as a loan; and creating a special fund in connection therewith.",

be amended to read as follows:

Section 1. That expenditures for civilian protection from the hazards of war in not exceeding the aggregate sum of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) are hereby authorized. The extent and purpose of all such expenditures shall be determined by the Municipal Defense Commission of the City of Seattle, subject to the approval of the President and of the Chairman of the Finance Committee of the City Council, and may include certain salaried personnel, necessary travel expense, rent, heat and light, supplies and equipment, and medical units. All purchases involving more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) shall be made through the City Purchasing Agent. All payrolls and bills shall be submitted to the Auditing Committee of the city for final approval before payment: Provided that expenditures in not exceeding the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) for a recreation center in Seattle for colored troops is hereby authorized and said amount, or so much thereof as may be necessary, shall be deducted from the aggregate sum herein authorized for civilian protection.



Section ~~2~~. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
