ORDINANCE NO. 73081

AN ORDINANCE relating to the municipal water supply system and providing for the acquisition by condemnation of certain land, property and property rights in Jefferson Park No. 2 Addition for additions and betterments to the Beacon Hill Water Reservoir site, and providing that the cost thereof shall be paid from the Water Fund.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That public necessity and convenience demand that the following described property:

Lots 1, 2 and 3, Block 7, and Lot 3, Block 9, Jefferson Park #2 Addition to the City of Seattle

be condemned, appropriated and taken for public use, to-wit: For additions and betterments to the existing Beacon Hill Reservoir site, a part of the water supply system of The City of Seattle.

Section 2. That the entire cost of such acquisition shall be paid from the Water Fund.

Section 3. That the Corporation Counsel is hereby authorized and directed to take the necessary actions and proceedings in the manner prescribed by law to carry out the provisions of this ordinance.

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
