ORDINANCE NO. 73911

AN ORDINANCE relating to construction and maintenance of the approaches to the University of Washington contemplated by Chapter 27, Laws of 1945.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the City of Seattle will within three months after the necessary real estate, rights and interests have been secured by the State of Washington begin the work of grading, paving and such other work as is necessary to complete and render available for use of the public, the approach to the University of Washington and the underpass and approaches to said underpass contemplated by Chapter 27, Laws of 1945, and that said city will thereafter keep and maintain said approach and underpass and approaches to said underpass in a good state of repair and suitable for public travel and use, which construction and maintenance work the said city is authorized and empowered by said Act to do and perform. This ordinance is enacted to fulfill the condition stated in Section 8 of said Chapter 27, Laws of 1945.

Section 2 This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
