AN ORDINANCE to narrow Aloha Street in the City of Seattle, and to vacate and release to the abutting property owners the parking strips on said Street between Queen Anne Avenue and Lake Union.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Aloha Street, in the City of Seattle, between Queen Anne Avenue and Lake Union, be and the same is hereby narrowed from eighty feet to sixty feet in width, thereby vacating and releasing to the abutting property owners the parking strips between the inner edge of the sidewalks and the property lines between said Avenues; Provided, That the notice required by state law shall be published and posted in accordance with such law.

Sec. 2. The right, without any payment therefor, to enter upon said strips at any and all times is hereby reserved for the City of Seattle for the purpose of sloping the same in order to protect the sidewalks from sliding earth.

Sec. 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
