ORDINANCE NO. 74647

AN ORDINANCE providing for the construction of a new shop building for the City Engineer's Department, and making an appropriation from the Cumulative Reserve Fund therefor.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Board of Public Works is authorized and directed to prepare plans and specifications for, and proceed with the construction of, a new shop building for the City Engineer's Department, said construction to be effected by the letting of a contract or contracts therefor, or the same or any part thereof may be done by day labor, in the discretion of the Board of Public Works.

77842 Section 2. That in order to effectuate said purpose the sum of One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Cumulative Reserve Fund, and the City Comptroller is authorized and directed to draw and deliver, and the City Treasurer to honor and pay, the necessary warrants therefor.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.

Dear Sir:

Pursuant to your request we have prepared and herewith transmit proposed ordinance providing for construction of a new shop building for the City Engineer's Department and making an appropriation from the Cumulative Reserve Fund therefor.

You requested an appropriation of \$200,000.00 but it appears from Comptroller's File No. 187302 that \$150,000.00 is for the building and \$50,000.00 for land acquisition. We have therefore made the appropriation in the proposed ordinance \$150,000.00 and we are advised that under direction of the Committee of the Whole the City Engineer is preparing and transmitting the ordinance relative to the local acquisition.

You also requested an ordinance appropriating \$100,000.00 from the Cumulative Reserve Fund for the Ballard-University Highway. The City Engineer advises that sufficient data is not yet available as to the locations, etc., of said improvement and we therefore refrain from preparing said ordinance at this time.
