ORDINANCE NO. 74741

AN ORDINANCE relating to and providing for the condemnation of Block 54, D. T. Denny's Home Addition as a facility for the Civic Auditorium, Ice Arena and Recreation Field.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Public necessity and convenience demand that the property described in Section 2 hereof be condemned, appropriated and taken for a facility (parking area) for the Civic Auditorium, Ice Arena and Recreation Field.

Section 2. That the full fee simple title to the following described real property situated in Seattle, King County, Washington, to-wit:

Block 54, D. T. Denny's Home Addition as recorded on page 115 of Volume 3 Plats of King County, Washington.

be and the same is hereby condemned, appropriated and taken as a facility (parking area) for the Civic Auditorium, Ice Arena and Recreation Field.

Section 3. The cost of this improvement shall be paid from any general funds applicable thereto.

Section 4. That the Corporation Counsel be and he is hereby authorized and directed to begin and prosecute the action and proceedings necessary in the manner provided by law to carry out the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
