ORDINANCE NO. 73021

AN ORDINANCE relating to and providing for the acquisition by condemnation of a right-of-way for sewer purposes over and across Lot 22, Block 3, Carleton Park Terrace Addition and providing for the payment therefor:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That public necessity and convenience demand that a right-of-way for sewer purposes be acquired by condemnation over and across the following described property situate in King County, Washington, to-wit:

The south 6 feet of Lot 22, Block 3, of Carleton Park Terrace, an addition to the City of Seattle, recorded in Volume 35 of plats at page 21, records of King County, Washington.

together with the right to encroach upon, occupy, use and damage in the original construction of said sewer, a strip of land 10 feet in width over and across said property, the southerly margin of said 10 foot strip coinciding with the northerly margin of the 6 foot strip above described; and

That only such rights in the land above described shall be acquired as shall be necessary for the construction, reconstruction, operation and maintenance of said sewer, reserving unto the owners thereof the right to use said property in any way and for any purpose not inconsistent with the right hereby authorized to be acquired.

Section 2. That the entire cost of the improvement provided for herein shall be paid from the City Street Fund or from such other fund as the City Council may by ordinance provide.

Section 3. That the Corporation Counsel be and he is hereby directed to begin and prosecute the actions and proceedings in the manner provided by law necessary to carry out the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 4.2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
