ORDINANCE NO. 75292

AN ORDINANCE relating to the proposed Alaskan Way Viaduct; creating the "Seattle Alaskan Way Viaduct--State Development Fund" to receive funds allocated for said project by the Washington State Development Board and making an appropriation from the Cumulative Reserve Fund in connection therewith.

WHEREAS the Washington State Development Board under authority of Chapter 255, Laws of Washington 1945, has approved an allocation of State funds for the construction of the Alaskan Way Viaduct partly on a matching basis and partly by outright grant, and

WHEREAS in order to make said State funds available it is necessary that a special fund be created for said project and the City's matching contribution be appropriated thereto: Now, Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

AMENDED ORD. 76278 Section 1. There is hereby created in the City Treasury a special fund designated the "Seattle Alaskan Way Viaduct--State Development Fund" into which shall be paid all moneys allocated by the Washington State Development Board under authority of Chapter 255, Laws of Washington 1945 for the construction of a four lane steel and concrete viaduct on Alaskan Way, together with any Federal grant for said project or the matching contribution of the City therefor and out of which shall be paid the cost of construction of said project. Expenditures from said Fund shall be under regulations established by the Washington State Development Board.

AMENDED ORD. 76278 Section 2. Pending allocation of Federal funds and in order to effectuate the City's matching contribution to the project specified in Section 1 hereof the sum of One Million Four Hundred and Ninety Five Thousand Dollars (\$1,495,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary is hereby transferred and appropriated from the Cumulative Reserve Fund to the "Seattle Alaskan Way Viaduct--State Development Fund" as an advance to be repaid when Federal funds are made available for said project and the City Comptroller is authorized and directed to draw and the City Treasurer to pay the necessary warrants therefor.

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.

Passed the City Council the 26 day of August, 1946, and signed by me in open session in authentication of its passage this 26 day of August, 1946, M. B. Mitchell President of the City Council.
