ORDINANCE NO. 75913

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Water Department; providing for the construction of a water tank north of Maple Leaf Reservoir and making an appropriation from the Water Fund therefor.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Board of Public Works is hereby authorized and directed to prepare plans and specifications for and proceed with the construction of a million gallon water tank with the appurtenant piping and equipment north of Maple Leaf Reservoir at East 86th Street and Roosevelt Way as contemplated by Comptroller's File No. 193460. Said construction shall be effected by the letting of a contract or contracts therefor, or the same or any part thereof may be accomplished by day labor in the discretion of the Board of Public Works.

AMENDED-ORD-76532 Section 2. That in order to effectuate said purpose the sum of One Hundred Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$160,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary is appropriated from the surplus in the Water Fund as an advance to capital account and the City Comptroller is authorized and directed to draw and the City Treasurer to pay the necessary warrants therefor.

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
