ORDINANCE NO. 76125

AN ORDINANCE vacating portion of North 32nd Street, et al., on petition of J. R. Burke, et al.

WHEREAS there has been filed with the City Council the petition of J. R. Burke, et al., (City Comptroller's File No. 195135), for the vacation of portion of North 32nd Street, et al., as therein fully described; and

WHEREAS at the hearing on said petition on the 14th day of October, 1947, said petition was duly granted by the City Council; Now, Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That

That portion of North 32nd Street, lying between the northeasterly line of the United States Government Lake Washington Canal and the west line of Fremont Avenue produced; that portion of North 33rd Street lying south of the southerly line of Northern Pacific Railway Company's 80-foot right of way extending along the northerly lines of Blocks 84 and 83, Denny & Hoyt's Supplemental Plat, according to the recorded plat thereof and a northwesterly production of said block lines, and lying east of a northerly production of the west line of Lot 20, Block 72, Denny & Hoyt's Addition to the City of Seattle, according to the recorded plat thereof; that portion of Evanston Avenue from the northeasterly line of said Lake Washington Canal to the produced southerly line of said North 33rd Street; and that portion of the alley lying between Blocks 80 and 81 of said Denny & Hoyt's Supplemental Plat, lying between the northeasterly line of said Lake Washington Canal and said produced west line of Fremont Avenue;

be and the same are hereby vacated; reserving to the City of Seattle the right to reconstruct, maintain and operate the existing overhead utilities over and across the area therein sought to be vacated until such time as the petitioners or their successors and assigns arrange with the owner or owners of said utilities for their removal.

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section 2.... This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
