ORDINANCE NO. 76721

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Police Department; providing for the acquisition by purchase or condemnation of land and other property in Section 3, Township 23, North, Range 4 East W. M. for a site for a rehabilitation camp for city prisoners.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That public necessity and convenience demand that the property described in Section 2 hereof be acquired by purchase or condemnation for a site for a rehabilitation camp for city prisoners.

Section 2. That the full fee simple title to the following described real property situated in King County, Washington, to-wit:

That portion of the north 505.21 feet of the south 1660.21 feet of the southwest one quarter of Section 3, Township 23 North, Range 4 East, W.M., lying between the easterly line of the Seattle Tacoma Interurban right of way and the westerly line of the Northern Pacific Railway right of way; less that portion thereof taken for State Highway No. 1, Duwamish Cutoff, connecting the Pacific and Sunset Highways

and all appurtenances thereunto belonging be and the same shall be acquired, condemned, appropriated and taken as a site for a rehabilitation camp for city prisoners in the event the same is not purchased.

Section 3. The cost of this improvement shall be paid from the Cumulative Reserve Fund.

Section 4. That the City Engineer is hereby authorized and directed to negotiate for the acquisition of said property and property rights by purchase and report to the City Council thereon and in case of the failure of the City Engineer to purchase and acquire said property the Corporation Counsel be and he is hereby authorized and directed to begin and prosecute the action and

proceedings necessary in the manner provided by law to acquire same by condemnation.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
