ORDINANCE NO. 77120

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Municipal Lighting and Power System and providing for the acquisition, by condemnation, of Block 66, D. T. Denny's Park Addition to North Seattle for a substation site.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That public necessity and convenience demand that the property described in Section 2 hereof be acquired by condemnation for public use, to-wit: A site for a substation for the Municipal Lighting and Power System of the City of Seattle.

Section 2. That the following described real estate, situate in King County, Washington, to-wit:

Block 66, D. T. Denny's Park Addition to North Seattle be so acquired for such purpose.

Section 3. That the cost of such acquisition be paid from the funds provided by Ordinance No. 76036.

Section 4. That the Corporation Counsel be, and he is hereby authorized and directed to begin and prosecute the action and proceedings necessary, in the manner provided by law, to carry out the provisions of this ordinance.

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
