ORDINANCE NO. 79458

AN ORDINANCE relating to the improvement of 31st AVENUE SOUTHWEST, from West Barton Street to West Cambridge Street, and certain other streets and avenues, by sewers, watermains, etc.; adding certain streets and avenues to the project; and amending Section 1 of Ordinance No. 79057.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 79057, entitled:

"AN ORDINANCE granting permission to Roxbury Homes, Inc., to improve 31st Avenue Southwest from West Barton Street to West Cambridge Street, and certain parts of certain other streets and avenues, by constructing sewers, etc. at its own cost and expense,"

approved June 21, 1950, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. That Roxbury Homes, Inc., be and it is hereby granted permission to improve:

31st AVENUE SOUTHWEST, from West Barton Street to West Cambridge Street; and
31st PLACE SOUTHWEST, from 31st Avenue Southwest to West Roxbury Street,

by constructing sanitary sewers together with the necessary appurtenances; also

31st AVENUE SOUTHWEST, from 31st Place Southwest to the alley in Block 4, Roxbury Addition;
WEST CAMBRIDGE STREET and the Same Produced across private property, from 30th Avenue Southwest to Longfellow Creek;
30th AVENUE SOUTHWEST, from West Cambridge Street to the Alley in Block 4, Roxbury Addition;
The ALLEY in BLOCK 4, ROXBURY ADDITION, from 31st Avenue Southwest to 31st Place Southwest;
AN EASEMENT across Block 3, Roxbury Addition as established by Ordinance No. 79304;

by constructing storm sewers together with the necessary appurtenances; providing for the necessary surface drainage; also

31st AVENUE SOUTHWEST, from West Barton Street to West Cambridge Street;
WEST CAMBRIDGE STREET, from 31st Avenue Southwest to 30th Avenue Southwest;
31st PLACE SOUTHWEST, from 31st Avenue Southwest to West Roxbury Street;
WEST ROXBURY STREET, from 30th Avenue Southwest to 32nd Avenue Southwest; and
30th AVENUE SOUTHWEST, from West Cambridge Street to West Roxbury Street;

by constructing watermains together with fire hydrants and the necessary appurtenances, all at its own cost and expense.

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
