ORDINANCE NO. 80625

AN ORDINANCE providing for the widening and paving of BROADWAY from Yesler Way to Fir Street, and appropriating money therefor from the City Street Fund.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Board of Public Works be and it is hereby authorized and directed to improve:

BROADWAY from Yesler Way to Fir Street, by widening and paving the same, and including as a part of said work the construction or reconstruction of all sewers, side sewers, watermains and hydrants with the necessary appurtenances; the construction of concrete sidewalks where necessary; by such grading or regrading as may be necessary; and doing such other work as may be necessary in connection therewith, all according to plans prepared by the City Engineer and approved by the Board of Public Works.

Said improvement shall be effected by the awarding of a contract or contracts therefor or in the discretion of said Board, the same or any part thereof may be done by day labor.

Section 2. That the sum of Eight Thousand Dollars (\$8,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated from the City Street Fund for the purpose set forth in Section 1 hereof.

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.

Gentlemen:

We are submitting herewith for your approval two council bills relative to Broadway from Yesler Way to Fir Street. One provides for the acceptance of a deed from the Seattle Housing Authority to rededicate this street which had previously been vacated in connection with the platting of Yesler Terrace Addition, and the other to widen and repave said street, at a cost of \$8,000.

It will be recalled from our communication contained in Comptroller's File No. 213184 that this street has never been closed by the Housing Authority but has remained in use continuously since the acceptance of the plat.

The Streets and Sewers Committee concurred in our recommendation contained in said file that the City, in return for a deed permitting the rededication, would pay the entire cost of widening and resurfacing the present roadway.
