ORDINANCE NO. 80816

AN ORDINANCE relating to and providing for the establishment and maintenance of a public sanitary and recreational center at 77 Washington Street ~~as proposed by the "Lutheran Compass Mission"~~ and making certain appropriations therefor.

WHEREAS, the "Lutheran Compass Mission" has proposed (Comptroller's Files Nos. 214762 and 215760) to remodel its building at 77 Washington Street for the establishment of a public sanitary and recreational center for the area; and

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission has made a survey of the need for such a center and has recommended that same be established at said location by remodeling as proposed; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the establishment of said center as proposed is in the public interest and for the general welfare; Now, Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the offer of the "Lutheran Compass Mission" (Comptroller's File No. 215760) to remodel the premises at 77 Washington Street for the establishment and maintenance of a public sanitary and recreational center for the area be accepted; the mission to provide the operating staff and the city the operating funds, all under the general supervision of, and subject to such inspection as may be deemed necessary by, the Superintendent of Buildings. This arrangement shall terminate December 31, 1962.

Section 2. To carry out the foregoing policy there is appropriated from the Cumulative Reserve Fund the sum of Twenty Seven Thousand Dollars (\$27,000) as contemplated by Resolution No. 15663, together with the entire unexpended balance in the Charles Brdar Special Fund created by Ordinance No. 78914. There is further appropriated for the operation of said facilities for the remainder of the current year 1952 the unexpended and unencumbered balance in the item "Sundry Supplies" segregation "Supplies and Expenses" in 1951 Budget of the Building Department which was withheld by Ordinance No. 80653. The City Comptroller is directed to draw and the City Treasurer to pay the necessary warrants therefor upon approval of the various items in writing by the Superintendent of Buildings.



Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.


