ORDINANCE NO. 80861

AN ORDINANCE relating to and providing for the acquisition by condemnation of a pipe line right of way for the water supply system of the City of Seattle over and across a portion of the northeast one-quarter of Section 11, Township 23 North, Range 4 East, W.M., and providing for the payment therefor from the Water Fund.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That public necessity and convenience demand that the following described property be and the same is hereby condemned, appropriated, taken and damaged for the public use for water pipe line purposes, to wit:

The north 30 feet of the west 390 feet of the north one-half of the northeast one-quarter of the northeast one-quarter of Section 11, Township 23 North, Range 4 East, W.M.;

and that only such rights shall be acquired as shall be necessary for the construction, reconstruction, alteration, operation and maintenance of said water supply pipe line reserving to the owner of said property all rights not inconsistent with the rights hereby sought to be acquired.

Section 2. That all lands, rights, privileges and other property lying within the limits of the tract of land described in Section 1 hereof be and the same are hereby condemned, appropriated, taken and damaged for water pipe line right of way purposes and said lands, rights, privileges and other property are to be taken, damaged and appropriated only after just compensation has been made or paid into court for the owners thereof in the manner provided by law.

Section 3. The entire cost of the improvement provided for herein shall be paid from the Water Fund.

Section 4. That the Corporation Counsel be and he is hereby authorized and directed to begin and prosecute the actions and proceedings in the manner provided by law to condemn, take, damage and appropriate the lands and other property necessary to carry out the provisions of this ordinance.

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section 5 This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.

Gentlemen:


We are submitting herewith for your approval council bill providing for the condemnation of a pipe line right of way for a portion of the Leo Street watermain, construction of which was authorized as a supply main by Ordinance No. 77486.

We have been able to acquire all of the right of way necessary for this supply main by negotiation without cost to the City.

In this particular instance, the contractual owner is willing to convey the necessary right of way to the City without cost but the fee owner is unwilling to deal with the City at all. As it is necessary that this main be constructed in the near future in order to provide adequate water for the Lake Ridge district for the coming summer, we respectfully request your approval of this bill.

The cost, if any, is to be paid by a subsequent appropriation from the Water Fund and should be nominal.



ORDINANCE NO. 80861

AN ORDINANCE relating to and providing for the acquisition by condemnation of a pipe line right of way for the water supply system of the City of Seattle over and across a portion of the northeast one-quarter of Section 11, Township 23 North, Range 4 East, W. M., and providing for the payment therefor from the Water Fund.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That public necessity

exists and it is hereby declared that the following described property be and the same is hereby condemned, appropriated, taken and damaged for the public use for water pipe line purposes, to-wit:

The north 20 feet of the west 330 feet of the north one-half of the northeast one-quarter of the northeast one-quarter of Section 11, Township 23 North, Range 4 East, W. M.;

and that only such rights shall be acquired as shall be necessary for the construction, reconstruction, alteration, operation and maintenance of said water supply pipe line reserving to the owner of said property all rights not inconsistent with the rights hereby sought to be acquired.

Section 2. That all lands, rights, privileges and other property lying within the limits of the tract of land described in Section 1 hereof be and the same are hereby condemned, appropriated, taken and damaged for water pipe line right of way purposes and said lands, rights, privileges and other property are to be taken, damaged and appropriated only after just compensation has been made or paid into court for the owners thereof in the manner provided by law.

Section 3. The entire cost of the improvement provided for herein shall be paid from the Water Fund.

Section 4. That the Corporation Counsel be and he is hereby authorized and directed to begin and prosecute the actions and proceedings in the manner provided by law to condemn, take, damage and appropriate the lands and other property necessary to carry out the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
