ORDINANCE NO. 81199

AN ORDINANCE relating to the acquisition by condemnation of certain lots in Blocks 121, 123, 138 and 148, Gilman's Addition for corporate uses including sanitary fill; and providing for payment from the Cumulative Reserve Fund.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That public necessity and convenience demand that the following described property, situated in Seattle, King County, Washington, to-wit:

East 50 feet of Lots 6 and 7, and west one-half of vacated street adjoining, Block 121, Gilman's Addition.

Lots 1, 2, 3, 8, 9, 10, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24 and 25, Block 123, Gilman's Addition.

Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 27 and 28, Block 138, Gilman's Addition.

Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 37, 38 and 43, Block 148, Gilman's Addition.

together with all rights, privileges and other property pertaining thereto, be and the same are hereby condemned, appropriated and taken for public use, to-wit, corporate uses including improvement by sanitary fill, said property to be so appropriated and taken only after just compensation has been made or paid into court for the owners thereof, in the manner provided by law.

Section 2. That the entire cost of such acquisition shall be paid from the Cumulative Reserve Fund.

Section 3. That the Corporation Counsel is hereby authorized and directed to begin and prosecute the actions and proceedings, in the manner provided by law, necessary to carry out the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
