ORDINANCE NO. 81578

AN ORDINANCE providing for the construction of concrete sidewalks on the north side of West Idaho Street from approximately 586 feet west of East Marginal Way to approximately 1130 feet west thereof, and otherwise improving the same; providing for the payment of the costs thereof from the Engineering Department Revolving Fund and providing for the reimbursement of said costs by the Chicago, Milwaukee, St. Paul and Pacific Railroad Company.

WHEREAS, The Chicago, Milwaukee, St. Paul and Pacific Railroad Company has requested (Comptroller's File No. 219381) that the City construct certain improvements on West Idaho Street as more completely described herein; and

WHEREAS, Said railroad company has agreed to pay the entire cost of said construction; Now, Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Board of Public Works be, and it is hereby authorized and directed to improve

WEST IDAHO STREET, north side only, from approximately 586 feet west of East Marginal Way to approximately 1130 feet west thereof

by the construction or reconstruction of concrete sidewalks; also

WEST IDAHO STREET from approximately 586 feet west of East Marginal Way to approximately 1130 feet west thereof

by the construction or reconstruction of watermains together with fire hydrants and the necessary appurtenances, and doing such other work as may be necessary in connection therewith, all in accordance with plans prepared by the City Engineer and approved by the Board of Public Works.

Section 2. That the costs of said improvement shall be advanced and appropriated from the Engineering Department Revolving Fund, provided that prior to the award of the contract therefor, the Chicago, Milwaukee, St. Paul and Pacific Railroad Company shall pay into the Guaranty Deposit Fund of the City for payment later to the Engineering Department Revolving Fund, a sum equal to the entire cost of the improvement, including engineering, contingencies, etc., as determined by the City Engineer; and provided further,

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

that if later it is determined that the amount of deposit is insufficient to pay all of the costs incurred by the City in behalf of said improvement, said railroad company shall be required to make up the deficit before the improvement is accepted by the Board of Public Works. Any funds on deposit not required to pay said cost shall be returned after acceptance by the Board of Public Works.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.

Gentlemen:

On November 24, we presented to you a council bill, No. 72928, providing for the construction of water-mains and concrete sidewalks on West Idaho Street, west of East Marginal Way.

Further examination of this bill shows that we had failed to provide for the expenditure of city funds and the reimbursement thereof, and therefore the Board of Public Works would not be able to act if it were enacted into law.

We transmit herewith a revised council bill, which provides that the construction be financed from the Engineering Department Revolving Fund which will be reimbursed from a deposit established in the Guaranty Deposit Fund by the Chicago, Milwaukee, St. Paul and Pacific Railroad Company prior to the award of the contract by the Board of Public Works.

We, therefore, respectfully request that this revised bill be substituted for Council Bill No. 72928, and that said Council Bill No. 72928 be indefinitely postponed.
