ORDINANCE NO. 81655

AN ORDINANCE relating to and providing for the annexation to the city of portions of Section 2, Township 25 North, Range 4 E., W.M.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Remington's Revised Statutes Section 8896 et seq, R.C.W. Sec. 35.13.010 et seq, residents of portions of Section 2, Township 25 North, Range 4 East, W.M. duly filed with the County Commissioners of King County a petition for annexation of the territory hereinafter described to the City of Seattle; and

WHEREAS, as shown by the duly certified abstract of votes and Resolution No. 13716 of the Board of King County Commissioners (Comptroller's File No. 219446) an election was duly held in said territory on the 18th day of November, 1952, at which a majority of the votes cast were for annexation and the Election Board of King County has so found and certified; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 16240, adopted January 9, 1953, the City Council has declared that it is expedient that such territory be annexed, Now, Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the following described contiguous territory,

to-wit:

Beginning at the intersection of the present City limits midway between East 92nd Street and East 94th Street and the center line of 15th Avenue Northeast;

Thence north along said center line to an intersection with the center line of East 120th Street; thence east along said center line to an intersection with the center line of 40th Avenue Northeast; thence north along said center line to an intersection with the center line of East 125th Street;

Thence east along said center line and the same produced to an intersection with the center line of Lake Washington; thence southerly along said center line of Lake Washington to an intersection with the production east of the south line of Section 2, Twp. 25 North, Range 4 East, W.M. (present city limits);

Thence west along said produced line and the south line of said Section 2, to an intersection with the east line of Sand Point Way, (present City limits); thence north along said east line to an intersection with the north line of the southwest one-quarter of Section 2, Township 25 North, Range 4 East W.M., (present City limits);

Thence west along said north line and the same produced to an intersection with the center line of 45th Avenue Northeast, (present City limits); thence north along said center line and the same produced to an intersection with the production east of the center line of East 85th Street, (present City limits);

Thence west along said produced line and the center line

of East 85th Street to an intersection with the center line of 20th Avenue Northeast, (present City limits);

Thence north along said center line to an intersection with the northwesterly line of Bothell Way, (present City limits); thence northeasterly and northerly along the northwesterly and westerly lines of Bothell Way to an intersection with a line midway between East 92nd Street and East 94th Street, (present City limits);

Thence west along said midway line to beginning.

be and the same is hereby annexed to the City of Seattle and from and after the 1st day of March, 1953 shall become and be a part of the City of Seattle subject to all the laws and ordinances thereof then and thereafter in force.

Section ...2.. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 16240, adopted January 9, 1953, the City Council has declared the territory annexed; Now, Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the following described contiguous territory, to-wit:

Beginning at the intersection of the present City limits midway between East 32nd Street and East 94th Street and the center line of 15th Avenue Northeast;

Thence north along said center line to an intersection with the center line of East 120th Street; thence east along said center line to an intersection with the center line of 40th Avenue Northeast; thence north along said center line to an intersection with the center line of East 125th Street;

Thence east along said center line and the same produced to an intersection with the center line of Lake Washington; thence southerly along said center line of Lake Washington to an intersection with the production east of the south line of Section 2, Twp. 25 North, Range 4 East, W. M. (present city limits);

Thence west along said produced line and the south line of said Section 2, to an intersection with the east line of Sand Point Way (present City limits); thence north along said east line to an intersection with the north line of the southwest one-quarter of Section 2, Township 25 North, Range 4 East, W. M. (present City limits);

Thence west along said north line and the same produced to an intersection with the center line of 45th Avenue Northeast (present City limits); thence north along said center line and the same produced to an intersection with the production east of the center line of East 85th Street (present City limits);

Thence west along said produced line and the center line of East 85th Street to an intersection with the center line of 30th Avenue Northeast (present City limits);

Thence north along said center line to an intersection with the northwesterly line of Bothell Way (present City limits); thence northeasterly and northerly along the northwesterly and westerly lines of Bothell Way to an intersection with a line midway between East 32nd Street and East 94th Street (present City limits);

Thence west along said midway line to beginning

be and the same is hereby annexed to the City of Seattle and from and after the 1st day of March, 1953, shall become and be a part of the City of Seattle subject to all the laws and ordinances thereof then and thereafter in force.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.




